Our club hosts monthly intro sessions designed to help newcomers learn the basics of various games, with hands-on guidance from our volunteers. These sessions are perfect for anyone new to the hobby or exploring a new game.

• **Table 1** Regular Free Play Nights:

On alternating weeks, we host free play evenings where members can book tables for games of their choice, whether it's competitive Warhammer, casual D&D, or board games with friends.

Babysitting Services:

While we welcome members of all ages, children under 15 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. Our volunteers are here to guide and support, but we are not responsible for childcare.

• Full-Length Games or Sessions During Showcase Events:

For events like our Open Day, activities are designed as showcases. You won't be sitting down for a full-length game, but you'll get to explore, ask questions, and sample the games we offer.

• Perfection in Skill or Experience:

Everyone starts somewhere, and we celebrate growth and learning. Whether you're a master tactician or rolling dice for the first time, you belong here!

Age Recommendations

- Most of our activities are best suited for ages 12+, but we acknowledge
 that every individual is unique. Some younger children may enjoy painting
 or simpler games, while older kids may need a bit more guidance.
- If you're bringing children under 10, please engage with them and help guide their experience to ensure a safe and enjoyable time.
